ABOUT NEWPORT BEACH, CALIFORNIA

Newport Beach, an opulent seaside community located on southern California's Orange County coastline between Los Angeles and San Diego, epitomizes the quintessential southern California lifestyle. Situated 55 miles south of Los Angeles, 85 miles north of San Diego and 26 miles from Catalina Island, on the coast of Orange County.
